General Notes:

- 1) Selecting “Record Maps” in the “More” (layers) menu will show all record maps: **Miscellaneous Records (MR)** which include Tract Maps; **Parcel Maps (PM)**; and **Records of Survey (RS)**.
- 2) Selecting “Survey Records” in the “More” (layers) menu will show **Corner Records (CR)**, **Unrecorded Maps (UM)** and **Centerline Tie Sheets** filed with the County Surveyor’s Office as well as **Benchmarks**.
- 3) The display of the locations (by approximate centroid point) is scale dependent in County View. If you select “Record Maps” and/or “Survey Records” and no points are displayed try zooming in to your area of interest.
