#### **ANNUAL PERMIT FOR POLE PLACEMENT CONDITIONS 2014**

Acceptance of this permit by the permittee indicates agreement with the following conditions and procedures. The said conditions and procedures are hereby made a part of the subject Annual Encroachment Permit. Any work in the road right-of-way without the authority of a separate permit for that location is a violation of the County Encroachment Ordinance 2041. The Annual Permit is valid for a calendar year, Jan 1<sup>st</sup> thru Dec 31<sup>st</sup>. Permittee shall be charged double the permit fees if the work is started prior to issuing a permit for that location.

# Permittee shall obtain a separate permit for each job location prior to start of work for the following types of work.

- 1. Pole placement and/or relocation.
- 2. For emergency repairs. A separate permit application should be completed the next business day. <u>Emergency repairs require an immediate phone notification</u> to our office at (805) 654-2055, and no later than the next business day.
- 3. Routine access/maintenance to utility company facilities within the paved travelled way where the speed limit is greater than 25 mph posted/observed.

## A separate permit is not required for the following types of work.

- 1. Routine access/maintenance to utility company facilities within the paved travelled way where the speed limit is 25 mph or less posted/observed.
- Routine access/maintenance to utility company facilities within the shoulder/sidewalk where there is no impact to the travelled way.

## Requirements for Application submittal

- 1. Exact location of pole and description of the work, including road name and distance from the nearest intersection or mile marker
- 2. Estimated start and completion date of the work.
- 3. Specify traffic control plan layout/figure from Watch Manual, CAMUTCD or provide an engineered traffic control plan.
- 4. Permittee, contractor and field contact information and phone number.
- 5. Application signed by the permittee or authorized agent of the Annual Permit holder.

Email application to <u>Trans.Permits@ventura.org</u>, fax to (805) 654-5169 or mail to Transportation Dept at 800 S. Victoria Ave, Ventura, CA 93009-1620. If you have a billing account, you will be billed for the appropriate amount. The approved permit will be emailed or faxed to you.

#### Permit requirements for all types of work

- a. It is the permittee's responsibility to notify the <u>Transportation Department at</u> (805) 654-2055 a minimum of 48 hours in advance of the date and time that you plan to begin work.
- b. The permit must be at the job site and must be available for inspection at all times.

#### **Traffic Control Restrictions**

- a. The Permittee shall furnish, install and maintain traffic control devices in accordance with Watch Manual, CAMUTCD or as required by the County's Traffic Engineer.
- b. No road closures are permitted. Two-way traffic shall be maintained at all times.
- c. There shall be no work on any road within 500 ft of any school during times indicated:

High Schools 7:30 am - 9:00 am 2:00 pm - 3:30 pm Junior Highs 8:00 am - 9:00 am 2:30 pm - 3:30 pm Elementary 7:30 am - 9:00 am 2:30 pm - 3:30 pm

d. No work that interferes with traffic may occur on the Major Collector Streets from 7:00 am to 9:00 am and 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm.
