

ANNUAL PERMIT FOR TREE TRIMMING CONDITIONS 2014

Acceptance of this permit by the permittee indicates agreement with the following conditions and procedures. The said conditions and procedures are hereby made a part of the subject Annual Encroachment Permit. The Annual Permit is valid for a calendar year, Jan 1st thru Dec 31st.

Permit requirements for all types of work

- a. It is the permittee's responsibility to notify the Transportation Department at (805) 654-2055 a minimum of 48 hours in advance of the date and time that you plan to begin work. Provide the contractor's name, address and phone number at this time, if different from the contractor listed on the Annual Permit.
- b. The permit must be at the job site and must be available for inspection at all times.
- c. The shapeliness of the tree shall be preserved when trimming.

Traffic Control Restrictions

- a. The Permittee shall furnish, install and maintain traffic control devices in accordance with the Watch Manual or CAMUTCD.
- b. No road closures are permitted. Two-way traffic shall be maintained at all times.
- c. There shall be no work on any road within 500 ft of any school during times indicated:

- d. No work that interferes with traffic may occur on the Major Collector Streets from 7:00 am to 9:00 am and 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm.

Limb / Root Pruning

Permit is contingent upon receipt of certification from a qualified tree consultant (arborist) that the roots and/or limbs may be pruned without leaving the tree unstable, or otherwise damage the tree.
